

MUUC Guidelines for Gatherings During The COVID-19 Pandemic.

MUUC shares the responsibility to help slow the growth of this pandemic in our communities. The best way to do that is to limit or curtail gatherings of people; we are doing that where it is within our control, based on common public policy recommendations.

- Starting March 15, on-site Sunday worship has been suspended and replaced by online audio and video. Please see ----- for details and schedules.
- Gatherings for MUUC programs and activities in our building are suspended until further notice.
- As of March 18, gatherings of more than 10 people for groups and businesses whom we host in our building are suspended until further notice. For gatherings of less than 10 people, we urge organizers and leaders to consider the important responsibility that MUUC shares for slowing the growth of this pandemic. We urge consideration of the urgency for the gathering against the degree of risk to the wider community. Clearly, the greater the number of people in a gathering, the greater the risk imposed on the wider community.

This does not affect the agreements between us and the Melrose Montessori School. The space they use is physically separate. We are in contact with them as they consider their responsibilities and consult with state education authorities.

MUUC will revise these guidelines as we get further guidance and recommendations about our responsibilities.

Please know that each other's health and safety, within and beyond our church community, is of paramount concern to us. And please know that our efforts are guided by the essential need to be and to stay connected and to support each other, within our spiritual home.
